

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Central Catholic is a high school of the Catholic Diocese of Youngstown, chartered by the State of Ohio and accredited by the Ohio Catholic Schools Accrediting Association and the North Central Association of Secondary Schools. The following are the requirements for graduation as prescribed by these organizations and Central Catholic High School.

Students will need a minimum of 20 credits plus a credit in Theology for each year attending a Catholic high school. (24 credits total)

Theology 4 credits

English 4 credits

Math 4 credits

Science 3 credits (Biology, Physical Science or Chemistry)

Social Studies 3 credits

Health/PE 1 credit

Business/Fine Arts/Foreign Language 1 credit (Most colleges prefer 2-3 years in the same foreign language)

Electives- to meet the credit requirement of 24 credits to graduate

Students will need to pass ALL sections of the Ohio Graduation Test
