FACTS Student Information System

Attached are the directions for using FACTS.

Kindergarten through third grade report cards are standards based. Students receive a 1, 2 or 3 for each standard that has been assessed during the nine-week grading period.

- 1 = Limited: Evidence and progress toward meeting the grade level standard is limited, even with guidance and support.
- 2 = Developing: Student is progressing toward the standard for the term and applies skills with increasing accuracy, quality of level of support needs vary.
- 3= Mastered: Student meets or exceeds the standard for the term with consistent success, accuracy, and independence.

Kindergarten and first graders do not receive report cards the first nine weeks. Grades for Kindergarten through third grade students are not posted on FACTS, therefore parents can't check their progress during the term. If you have a concern about your child's progress send a note or email the classroom teacher.

Parents in K-3 can use FACTS to check attendance and lunch account info.

Fourth through sixth grade report cards are based on grades earned during the term. Parents can view assignments and grades using FACTS. Attached are the directions for using FACTS to view assignments, grades, attendance and lunch account information. If you have a concern about your child's progress send a note or email the classroom teacher.
